

The NSGIC Lifetime Service Award

Summary

The NSGIC Lifetime Service Award is presented to an individual that has given a 'lifetime' of noted, dedicated and distinguished service to NSGIC. This person need not be in a leadership position. This award is typically given at the conclusion of the recipient's career or at a transition point in their career, although this is not a requirement. As this is one of NSGIC's highest service award recognition, a recipient's exemplary service must exceed the normal expectation of duty and have occurred over an extended period of time.

The Lifetime Service Award can be presented either during the Business Meeting at the NSGIC Annual Conference or during a special session at the NSGIC Midyear Conference. Award recipients will receive a plaque mounted on a walnut base.

Eligible Nominees

The actions of each nominee must meet the following criteria:

- 1) An extended career of service with their respective organization.
- 2) A career of dedicated and distinguished service to NSGIC.
- 3) Promote NSGIC's goal of efficient and effective government through prudent adoption of geospatial technologies

Nomination Procedures

The Awards Subcommittee will solicit nominations each year in December (Midyear) or June (Annual). Only current or former NSGIC Board Members or Officers may nominate eligible individuals for this award. Nominations will be sent to the Awards Subcommittee to be verified for eligibility. Nominations must include detailed information concerning the nominee's specific activities and responsibilities that make them eligible for the award. The Awards Subcommittee will acknowledge receipt of each nomination.

The initial nomination must be endorsed by at least one other current or former NSGIC Board Member.

Selection process

Nominations will be verified for eligibility by the Awards Subcommittee. Each nominee will be individually evaluated according to the award criteria. All Lifetime Service Award nominations will be considered at the same time on a competitive basis at the Subcommittee meeting in January or February (Midyear) or August/September (Annual). The subcommittee will make a recommendation and the final decision will be made by the President.
